

## **Summary of Use of Funds for ESSR III Grant 9/21/21**

Superintendent Jones presented the ESSR III budget page to the Board of Education in their BOE packet. He reviewed the grant with all members present except for member Andrea Holmes. In summary, there was a total allotment of \$12,290 provided to Hollis Consolidated School District #328 in the ARP - LEA American Rescue Plan (ESSR III).

Hollis plans to spend \$3,000 of that allotment to address learning loss by hiring 3 teachers to teach summer school. Each teacher will make \$1,000 for teaching students identified with school staff collected data during the 2021-22 school year. The summer school program will last approximately 4-6 weeks.

Hollis plans to spend \$525 to pay for benefits for their summer school teachers including FED TRS, TRS, ETHIS, and MEDICARE.

Hollis plans to spend \$154 on summer school supplies to provide resources needed to conduct an successful summer school program to assist it's students with learning loss.

Hollis plans to purchase new science lab tables for it's junior high science room to provide necessary social distancing in this classroom for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students. Hollis plans to spend \$8,400 on these supplies.

Hollis plans to spend \$211 on purchasing more sanitation and disinfecting supplies to keep the building disinfected and Covid free to the best of their ability.

There were no objections by any BOE member in attendance on the use of these funds and there were no objections by the general public at the Board of Education meeting that night.
